Global Learning Day at Caedmon College Whitby, Tuesday 11 June 2019

On Tuesday 11 June, the Year 6 students, who are planning to come to Caedmon College in September, are invited to a Global Learning Day. This is an exciting day with different workshop activities for the children to participate in with a global theme.

The day will start at 8.55am and the students are to come directly to the College (Scoresby Site) rather than first going to their primary school. The students who need to travel on the bus or train to College will be able to do so as the bus companies have been informed. Students arriving at Whitby train station will be picked up by the College mini bus. Your son/daughter should wear their primary school uniform and bring a waterproof jacket and suitable outdoor shoes as there will be some outdoor activities taking place. We would like to invite your son/daughter to each bring (up to) a suggested voluntary donation of £1, which can be exchanged at a "bureau de change" and spent in our "French Patisserie" (this is optional).

On arrival, the children will all meet in the hall (next to the reception area), on the College's Scoresby Site, where they will be allocated a group. We will make sure that they know someone in their group (as far as is possible). The children will then rotate around the workshops in their groups. The workshops will include digital learning, learning outside the classroom and some food tasting. Please ensure that we are informed of any food allergies that your son/daughter has, ahead of the day, on the reply slip enclosed. There will be a break time where your son/daughter is welcome to either eat something from our "French Patisserie" or have a snack brought from home. Please could you provide your son/daughter with a packed lunch for lunchtime. If your child is currently in receipt of free school meals, a lunch will be provided.

The day will end at 3.15pm and students should be collected from the Scoresby Site. Students who travel home on a bus will need to stay until 3.30pm when they can get on their bus from the Scoresby Site. If you would like your son/daughter to walk home from the College, please also indicate this on the reply slip below. The reply slip should be returned directly to Caedmon College (Scoresby Site). Please can you do so by Friday 17 May 2019.
